

How to Get Your Prayers Answered

James 4:1-10

Oh, what peace we often forfeit, Oh, what needless pain we bear, All because we do not carry, Everything to God in prayer.

Prayer that Goes Unanswered:

- 1. Unoffered Prayer (James 4:2b)
- 2. Selfish Prayer (James 4:3)
- 3. Worldly Pray-ers (James 4:4)

Effective Prayer [adapted from Adrian Rogers]

- 1. Sensitivity to the Spirit (James 4:5)
- 2. Submission to the Father (James 4:6-7)
- 3. Standing Against the Devil (James 4:7b)

How To Get Your Prayers Answered:

- **1.** We should pray in faith (James 1:6, "But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.")
- **2.** We should pray in the name of Jesus (John 16:24, "Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.")
- **3.** We should pray according to the will of God (1 John 5:14, "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.")
- **4. We should pray only when we are in right relationship with others** (1 Peter 3:7, "Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.")
- **5.** We should pray with no unconfessed sin in our life (*Psalm 66:18, "If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear."*)
- **6.** We should pray with intensity (James 5:16, "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.")
- **7.** We should pray with persistence (Luke 18:1, "Then Jesus spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart." See also Matt. 7:7-11).
